ACADEMY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

There are 40 places available, and these will be allocated based on applications.

- Completed applications should be sent to hnf-tr.phmacademy@nhs.net
- Application deadline 5 pm on 1st November 19

Participants will be required to commit 3 days per month from December to April.

- *2 days of classroom training in Leeds*
- *1 day of independent study and coursework*

The course is free for participants, but non-attendance will incur a fee.



APPLICATION & NEXT STEPS

- The Yorkshire and Humber PHM Academy is open to all organisations within the region
- Individuals can apply for the programme directly by sending a CV and completed application form to hnf-tr.phmacademy@nhs.net
- Organisations can refer individuals for the programme by emailing through their nominations
- The application deadline is 1st November at 5pm
- The outcome of the application will be communicated by 5pm on 8th November
- Successful applicants will need to confirm their place on the course by 15th November
- Unsuccessful applicants will be added to a waitlist and will be informed if a place becomes available from 18th November



Further information

- A certificate of completion will be awarded to participants attending at least seven of the ten teaching days
- The Academy is free to attend
- Participants who do not attend will be charged a fee of £100
- Applicants will require approval from their line managers
